### Quick Facts

**Location:** On a map or globe, find the triangle-shaped land of India, in Southern Asia. Bangladesh is just to the right of this triangle. India surrounds Bangladesh on three sides. Bangladesh is the size of our state of Wisconsin.

**The Land:** Most of Bangladesh is a delta. A delta is a flat, wet triangle of land formed by rivers. More than 200 rivers provide waterways for boats. The moist soil is good for growing rice and other food. Hills rise up in the southeastern part of Bangladesh. The jungles here are home to monkeys, boars, jackals, tigers, leopards, and elephants.

**Population\*:** 162.6 million

**Capital City\*:** Dhaka (20.28 million)

**People Groups\*:** Bengali (98%), tribal groups

**Languages\*:** Bangla (official, also called Bengali), Arabic, Urdu, and tribal languages.

**Religions\*:** Muslim (89%), Hindu (10%), other (including Buddhist and Christian)
